What you need to know

TIMING & RESULTS

Your bib contains a timing chip to be worn during the race. It must be worn on the front of your body. No chip = no time. Visit sportstats.one or <u>runthederby.com</u> for your results. Awards will be given to the top finishers, categories can be found on runthederby.com.

FOOD TENT

We will be offering lots of food this year. Look for Kwik Trip Glazers, chocolate milk, bananas, granola bars, and more—easy to grab and go.

YOUR PHOTOS

A pre-race photo station will be available near the Start (see map), as well as post-race photos before the Food Tent. The photos will be FREE to download after the event. You will be sent a link to your photos by Friday, November 29.

STROLLERS

Yes, you can run/walk with strollers, but runners with strollers must line up at the end of the 5K run, in front of the walkers.

MUSIC

Earbuds or headphones are discouraged in case you will need to hear any announcements by police or rescue personnel. Wear at your own risk.

KIDS UNDER 10

All children under age 10 **MUST** be accompanied by a guardian during the race. Any lost kids should report to the Registration tent Lost & Found.

THROUGH THE WOODS AND UP THAT HILL

The Birdie Derby 5K course takes you straight down Fish Hatchery Road and into the DNR. Make some quick twists and turns before hitting the hill on Woods Hollow taking you to the finish line!





10K Course

EXPLORE THE DANE COUNTRY TRAIL SYSTEM

The Birdie Derby 10K course takes you from the Agora Pavilion to the flat and fast Fish Hatchery Road before entering the trails. Enjoy the beautiful fall colors as you run through the Dane County trail system and finish with the challenging hill you know and (maybe) love.

The Birdie Derby directly funds financial aid and grants for schools so thousands of children can participate in events and afterschool programs where they learn how to build confidence, set goals, work as a team, and love movement. The kids build a connection between movement and how it impacts our mental and physical healthy.

2024 impact results include:



Donated over \$41,000 to Dane County Schools to fund physical education departments



412 children received or borrowed bikes to enjoy the freedom that biking offers



127 NEW pairs of shoes were donated to kids who did not have them



T4S awarded a \$1,500 continuing education scholarship to a T4S alumn



Funded \$34,000+ in scholarships so economically disadvantaged kids could participate
